A notification has been received from Essex County Council giving notice of a proposed implementation of a 'No Waiting at Any Time' Restrictions on Bell Common. Further to the consultation carried out in relation to the above scheme, Essex County Council wrote to confirm that in the coming weeks the No Waiting at Any Time Restrictions, will be installed on Bell Common, as set out in the original order, as advertised on 23rd June 2022. During the consultation, comments were received from residents indicating they were not in agreement with the proposals. All objections were taken into account. The decision to install the No Waiting at Any Time Restrictions, Bell Common, was approved by the Essex County Council Cabinet Member for Infrastructure on 18th January 2023, under reference FP-015-01-23 and as such, the proposed scheme will proceed as originally stated.
