314 JACK SILLEY PAVILION INTERNAL WORKS AND PROGRESS

Members discussed the internal works, café kitchen, Essex Room floor and progress on the Jack Silley Pavilion. Members discussed these issues in relation to their financing.

It was **RESOLVED** that the following RECOMMENDATIONS would be made to Council:

- (i) The café area could be hired as a bookable space until café operations begin;
- (ii) The Forest Room, hallway and toilets should be decorated, but the Essex Room delayed until after the insurance investigations/work are undertaken;
- (iii) The current contractors should complete this work;
- (iv) £1800 received from Dalcour Maclaren for reservoir works should be used to part finance these decorations, with the remainder taken from the Capital Fund

- (opening balance 2018/19 was £52,967). Total cost of works £4400 (£2600 to come from the Capital Fund);
- (v) The kitchen should not be fitted out at the current time, until more information is available on potential lessees' requirements and funding;
- (vi) Two replacement signs to be ordered in white on green with Epping Town Council logo.

315 FURTHER ACTION REQUIRED

The Town Clerk would continue to chase the insurance company/surveyor's regarding the Essex Room floor situation.

The Town Clerk would advertise the café expressions of interest more widely and with local catering companies.
